### TLIF2080C Safely Access the Rail Corridor

#### Course overview:

The unit TLIF2080C Safely Access the Rail Corridor is the unit of competency, which has been developed to meet the applicable legislated rail safety requirements including acts and regulations from the applicable state or territory together with any nationally approved compliance codes and/or guidelines.

This training is applicable to the Sydney Trains network and delivered under license to Transport for NSW.

Upon successful completion of this course participants will receive a Statement of Attainment. Please note that the SOA in itself is not enough to work in the rail corridor. You must apply for and be issued with a RIW card.

Participants must complete a 100 point id check and pass the Category 3 Medical assessment from an authorised medical practitioner prior to applying for an RIW card.



#### Learning Outcomes:

On successful completion of training, participants will have an understanding of rail terminology, basic signalling indications, rules and regulations for people working in the rail corridor, knowledge of a safe place, Electrical safety, personal & legal requirements of fatigue, drugs and alcohol.

#### Who can enrol?

- Individuals who will undertake work accessing the Sydney Trains Rail Corridor.
- Individuals who are able to satisfy the requirements of Category 3 medical assessment

#### Issue of RIW Card:

In order to receive an RIW card, participants must upload their Statement of Attainment together with page 3 of the signed Cat 3 medical assessment onto the Pegasus Onsite System.

#### Program Schedule: Tuesdays & Thursdays 0800 to 1600 (Other Week day, weeknight and weekend sessions available for 10+ bookings)

Attendance of a minimum 6 hours of face-to-face learning and completion of assessment tasks is mandatory in order to complete this unit of competency. Six (6) hours of face-to-face learning does not include breaks. You will be required to arrive 30 minutes ahead of the nominated start time to confirm all enrolment details are completed.

## Location:

The training is conducted at Swetha International Pty Ltd training rooms at:

## Requirement for attending Training:

To attend training on the day you must:

- Have confirmed enrolment details and paid the course fee
- **Bring a pen** to take notes and complete the assessment
- Provide a government issued photo ID (driver's license etc).
- wear appropriate clothing to be able to perform in group activities and demonstrations

## Fees and Charges:

The course fee of \$250 includes workbook and assessment material.

We also provide a combined training and medical assessment package for \$450 (this saves up to \$100).

Cost for issue of RIW card and uploading data to rail industry worker onsite system is additional to the course fee and payable to Pegasus (currently \$100 + GST).

## Assessment

Learning and assessment activities will be conducted by assessors using a range of evidence gathering techniques throughout the course, including written and practical demonstrations. Your trainer will provide you with any support you may require with your assessment throughout the training.

If you are assessed as “Not yet competent” on the first attempt, you will be given another opportunity to demonstrate your competence. If you are still not successful after this you may need to reenroll and repeat the unit of work.

## Pre-requisites

There are no pre –requisites or co-requisites units of competency for this course however as this course requires you to read, write and communicate in English, you must demonstrate adequate English language skills. If you are unable to demonstrate that you can communicate effectively in English and have the appropriate literacy levels to participate in this program you may be required to complete a simple language, literacy and numeracy test.
